### UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS (UAS/DRONES)

**POLICY:** The Solano Community College District regulates the use of Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS), commonly known as drones, on or above District property and in connection with District-sponsored activities in order to promote safety, protect privacy, and ensure compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

The operation of UAS on District property or as part of District activities is prohibited unless authorized in accordance with District administrative procedures.

All approved UAS operations must comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations, including Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements.

The Superintendent/President shall establish administrative procedures to implement this policy, including requirements for authorization, operational safety, and privacy protections.
