WHEREAS, District and Consultant entered into an Architectural Engineering Services Agreement ("Agreement"), dated January 17, 2024, for services related to the District's **B600 Governing Board Room Project** ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, District and Consultant previously amended the Agreement on July 17, 2024, for additional Consultant Services related to the District's **B600 Governing Board Room Project** ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, District and Consultant agree to further amend the Agreement to modify the services performed for the District's **B600 Governing Board Room Project** ("Project"); and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth above and contained herein, District and Consultant agree as follows:

#### **AGREEMENT**

- 1. Section 1. Term of the Agreement is amended to read:
  - **1. Term.** Consultant shall commence providing services under this Agreement on January 17, 2024 and will diligently perform as required and complete performance by April 15, 2025, unless this Agreement is terminated and/or otherwise cancelled prior to that time.
- 2. Except as set forth in this Amendment, all provisions of the Agreement and any previous extension(s) and/or amendment(s) thereto shall remain unchanged, in full force and effect, and are reaffirmed. This Amendment shall control over any inconsistencies between it and the Agreement and/or any previous extension(s) and/or amendment(s).
- 3. Consultant acknowledges and agrees that this Amendment shall not be binding on the Parties until and unless the Solano Community College District's Governing Board approves this Amendment.
