# **SUMMARY:**

## CONTINUED FROM THE PREVIOUS PAGE

During the process of construction and RFI (Request for Information)/Submittal review, the following changes needed to be made:

- 1-Hr Fire Rated Corridor (COR 10.1): During demolition it was discovered that the existing central corridor was not a 1-hr rated corridor as required by code. This corridor needed to be brought up to current code. This was an unforeseen condition.
- Shallow Electrical Conduits (COR 12.2): During demolition shallow electrical conduits were discovered under the existing concrete slab. These conduits needed to be relocated since they conflicted with the installation of new work. These conduits are the main electrical feeds for Building 1600 and Building 200. This was an unforeseen condition.
- Cosmetology FF&E (COR 13.1): Per CCD #6 it was requested that the contractor purchase and install cosmetology related Furniture, Fixtures, and equipment. This was not originally part of the contractor's scope of work.

EF Brett & Company's Change Order No. 01 request includes all the costs of both time and materials for the above listed items and extends the contract completion date to November 15, 2025.
